

Where Can I Register to Vote?

Voter Registration is governed in Alabama by state law and the federal National Voter Registration Act (NVRA).

Qualifications –

To register to vote in the state of Alabama, an individual must meet the following qualifications:

- ✓ Be a United States Citizen
- ✓ Reside in Alabama
- ✓ Be at least 18 years old
- ✓ Have not been convicted of a disqualifying felony
- ✓ Have not been legally declared “mentally incompetent” by a court

Deadline for Registering to Vote –

Voter Registration is closed for the ten (10) days before an election.
