For workplace injuries immediately call to speak with a registered nurse who will evaluate your incident. Our nurses specialize in occupational injuries and will connect you with the quality care you need.



What to expect during the call

- 1. The injured worker will be asked the following:
 - a. Employer & Department name
 - b. Personal information including Social Security Number (either complete or the last 4 digits)
 - c. A call back number
 - d. Occurrence details—what, where, and when
 - e. Personal medical information
 - f. After first aid or medical treatment advisement is given, the injured worker will be transferred to a team member who will assist in completing the report of injury, including faxing a one-time only use pharmacy card and treatment authorization to the treating facility.
- 2. The average length of a call is about 12 minutes.
- 3. If medical treatment advisement is given, upon arrival at treating facility you will be given a drug and alcohol test.
- 4. If the call has a First Aid advisement, the employee is required to report to the appropriate facility for mandatory drug and alcohol testing. Contact Risk Management, 205-325-5110, or complete the Drug/Alcohol Screening Authorization form.
 - a. Expect a call back from the nurse within 24 hours on first aid calls to ascertain the status of the medical condition.
 - b. Employees are also given the nurse's direct line to initiate a call back if necessary.
