What To Bring From Home

The following will be accepted in household quantities.
No commercial waste accepted.

- Aerosol spray cans (with content)
- Batteries (auto and alkaline)
- Electronics (TVs, computers, cell phones, etc.)
- Fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides
- Fire extinguishers, smoke detectors
- Household cleaners (bleach, drain, metal, oven, polishes, toilet)
- Large appliances (washers, dryers, refrigerators, freezers)
- Motor oil and vehicle fluids (antifreeze, brake fluid, mixed gas)
- Paint (latex and oil based)
- Paper (paper shredding available)
- Stains, varnishes and solvents (thinners, strippers and removers)
- Tires
- Used cooking oil

Do NOT Bring

The following will **NOT** be accepted including unidentified materials and containers.

- Agricultural chemicals
- Asbestos
- Business waste
- Commercial waste
- CFLs
- Explosives
- Freon canisters
- Furniture or mattresses
- Lawn equipment
- Medical waste (syringes)
- Prescription medications
- PCBs
- Radioactive material

First come, first served. Collection will close when capacity is met.
