Given the steady number of new daily confirmed COVID-19 cases in this circuit, and the vaccination rate of approximately nineteen percent (19%) of the population, facial coverings remain a requirement for all parties, attorneys, witnesses, jurors, members of the public and Court personnel for the next sixty (60) days in all courtrooms of the Tenth Judicial Circuit. Removal may be authorized by individual Judges. This Court's previous Orders of May 15, 2020 and August 12, 2020 remain in effect as they relate to social distancing and other safety precautions inside of the courtrooms. This extension likewise applies to the Clerks' Offices.

Jury trials are in full force and effect.
