This will include all permits for: food & lodging, onsite sewage/septic tank, body art, swimming pools & spas, and open burning permits.

Applications for Community Environmental Protection - onsite sewage disposal systems, subdivisions, body art facilities, and swimming pools/spas may be submitted by email to onsite@jcdh.org or regular mail to 1400 Sixth Avenue South, Birmingham, AL 35233. Applications for Food and Lodging - food permits, lodging, child care centers, and food establishment plan review, requests for food permits, lodging permits, child care centers, as well as food, lodging or childcare plan review may be submitted by email to Food&Lodging@jcdh.org or regular mail to 1400 Sixth Avenue South, Birmingham, AL 35233. Applications for Air and Radiation Protection- open burning or air pollution permitting, applications for open burning applications, or questions regarding air permitting, please call 205-930-1276. All permits administered by Air Pollution Control are excluded.
