**JEFFERSON COUNTY COMMISSION TO HOLD EMERGENCY MEETING
2 P.M. MARCH 31, 2020 VIRTUALLY**

Birmingham, AL – In the continued State of Emergency declared by Governor Kay Ivey and the increased spread of the COVID-19 Coronavirus, the Jefferson County Commission will convene virtually for an emergency meeting on Tuesday, March 31, 2020 at 2:00 PM. The meeting will be held in accordance with sect. 3 of the open meeting act of the proclamation from Governor Ivey on March 18, 2020. The meeting will be live streamed via Zoom on the County’s Facebook Channel @JeffersonCoAL. Items to be discussed include extending the closure of the courthouse and the purchase of medical equipment in anticipation of a COVID-19 case surge.
